Client progress through program will determine length of stay. Referrals are made to community resources for addiction and mental health treatment.

Admission Criteria: Adult male felony offenders on supervision (parole, transitional control, post release control or probation).

Exclusionary Criteria: Extensive medical or mental health issues, repeat violent offenders, arson, kidnapping, murder, sex offenders and treatment refusal.

Transportation to and from work within an 11 mile radius of the site. Client progress through program will determine length of stay.

Admission Criteria: Adult male felony offenders on supervision (parole, transitional control, post release control or probation). Must be able to provide own medication.

Exclusionary Criteria: Extensive medical or mental health issues, repeat violent offenders, arson, kidnapping, murder and treatment refusal.

Exclusionary Criteria: Extensive medical or mental health issues, repeat violent offenders, arson, kidnapping, murder, sex offenders and treatment refusal.
