### **Parkway Center receives \$98,500 grant for homeless men and veterans**

CINCINNATI— Talbert House has been awarded a grant of \$98,500 by the Louis & Louise Nippert Charitable Foundation. The funds will be used to support case management for approximately 184 homeless men and veterans through Parkway Center. The transitional housing program helps these men overcome barriers to housing, achieve and maintain steady sources of income, and secure mainstream benefits. Funds will also be used to provide a safe and secure environment for the residents.
