Talbert House Engagement Center Awarded \$50,000 Grant

CINCINNATI— A triage unit for individuals struggling with opiate addiction, The Engagement Center provides care and resources post overdose. The goal is to connect men and women with immediate support as well as access to treatment services and planning for successful long-term recovery.

Thanks to the generosity of the Jacob G. Schmidlapp Trusts, Fifth Third Bank, Trustee, a \$50,000 grant will fund medical equipment, furnishings, and recovery support resources to enhance care delivery at the Engagement Center.
