Talbert House names Ellis-Mazzaro and Boberg as Directors

CINCINNATI— Lora Ellis-Mazzaro has been promoted to the position of Talbert House’s Housing Director. Lora has been with the Agency since 2015 serving as a supervisor and most recently as an Associate Director under the Housing service line, expanding her technical expertise and program management experience.

In her role as Director, Lora will oversee programs offering housing to Agency clients with a history of homelessness, mental health, or substance use, and those reentering the community from the criminal justice system.

Nichol Boberg will be moving to the position of Director of Youth Services under the Agency’s Mental Health service line. Nichol has been with Talbert House for over 8 years, developing her passion for youth programming.

Among the programs Nichol will oversee as Director are Girls Residential Treatment, School-Based Behavioral Health Services, Union Day Therapeutic Day School, and Youth Case Management and Outpatient Services. She will also continue in a leadership role with Camp Possible, a therapeutic-based summer program for children struggling with behavioral health issues.
